Toilet Paper Roll Binoculars

Outside your window is a whole world of wonder! Scientists use binoculars to focus on certain objects or animals to carefully observe them. If you could get a closer look at something inside or outside your house, what would it be?

Know before you begin

- This activity can be done inside or outside
- All supplies are easy to find, substitute, or modify
- Adult supervision is recommended
- Please choose a safe space to use

Materials

- Two toilet paper rolls or one paper towel roll
- Scissors (please use with adult supervision)
- A shoelace, string, yarn, or other material for a neck strap
- Tape or glue
- Markers, crayons, or other decorating materials

Instructions

- Glue or tape the toilet paper rolls together. If using a paper towel roll, carefully cut in half and glue or tape together.
- Poke two holes, on the outside ends of the rolls, for the neck strap.
- Decorate and customize as desired.
- Once all glue, paint or other decoration has dried, use to explore the world!
